

2010 WESTERN PHOTO COMPETITION - RULES & REGULATIONS

The Western Photo Gallery Committee (WPGC) of the Calgary Stampede (CS) showcases Western heritage through photography. As part of the WPGC, we are again re-introducing a Western Photo Competition for 2010. The WPGC will select winning photographs through a jury process, and invites photographers to submit images for this competition.

Eligibility

The Western Photo Competition 2010 (WPC 2010) is open to photographers from around the world. By submitting an entry, each contestant agrees to the rules of the contest and states that they are 18 years old and older.

Volunteers of the Western Photo Gallery Committee and their immediate families are not eligible to submit an entry or entries to the Western Photo Competition

General

The WPGC and the CS reserve the right to reject any entry that does not conform to the rules and regulations outlined or, in the opinion and at the discretion of the WPGC and CS, are not deemed to be appropriate for the intended viewing audience. The decision of the WPGC and CS is final.

By submitting an entry or entries implies that the entrant accepts all the conditions, rules and regulations of the WPC and CS.

The entrant must be the sole owner and must hold all rights to any image or part thereof of any entry or entries. Any entry or entries submitted by the entrant must be his or her original work. By submitting an entry or entries, the entrant accepts that his or her work can be reproduced with no further compensation in media that is associated with the WPC and the CS. This includes, but is not exclusive to, being put on a website or in a brochure. All other rights remain with the entrant.

While WPGC and CS take reasonable and responsible steps to ensure that the information, links, images, and text on this website are accurate, WPGC and CS make no representations or warranties as to the completeness or accuracy of the information. The WPGC and CS accept no liability for any errors or omissions in the content of this site.

Themes

The WPGC and CS are proud to promote and showcase Western heritage in keeping with the rich history of Alberta and CS. The four (4) Themes of the WPC reflect this heritage. They are Western Landscape, Western Lifestyle, Rodeo and First Nations.

Submission of Photographs

All entries must be submitted in a digital format in a manner outlined below.

Images or any part of the final image may be created and/or modified digitally. Further to that, images or any part of the final image may be originally in a traditional film or slide format and then scanned into a digital format. Digitally enhanced or modified images ARE allowed. If an image is heavily modified, it should still be recognizable as fitting one of the four Themes.

The entrant is responsible for obtaining a model release, where necessary, from any identifiable person or persons featured in any entry. The model release should be made available on request to WPGC should the need arise. A signed model release gives consent from the identifiable person or persons to the photographer for public display. Any identifiable person under 18 years of age must have a model release signed for them by a parent or legal guardian.

Ensure that you submit your entry in the most appropriate category; it will not be transferred to a category that is, in the opinion of the judges, more appropriate.

Entries must be received by 11:59 P.M. Mountain Standard Time on April 30th, 2010 to be eligible for the Western Photo Competition. No entries will be accepted after that time. All entries must be submitted in a digital format as outlined below.

Images must be in a **JPEG (JPG) format** only. Images should be submitted in the best resolution possible, with the overall file submission no greater than 2MB in file size. The photographer's signature or any identifying marks must not be visible on the digital images submitted to the jury.

Any entry deviating from this format will not be accepted.

An entry fee of \$10.00 (Canadian Dollars) per entrant, regardless of the number of submissions, must accompany registration. The entrant may submit a maximum of five (5) entries in total.

Neither the WPGC nor the CS are responsible for lost entries, misdirected entries, unreadable entries or entries that have digital artifacts or defects.

Images not adhering to the submission guidelines will not be accepted.

Judging

Entries will be judged on image quality, technical ability, composition, and adherence to the category in which the entry has been submitted. Entries will be displayed and judged in the condition they are submitted. To ensure that the entry or entries is viewed most favourably, ensure that the computer monitor that the entry is created upon is properly calibrated.

Entries will be pre-judged on quality and adherence to the themes and rules. Any entries not meeting these standards will not be accepted for showing or eligible for prizes.

By entering the WPC, the entrant agrees and understands that photography is subjective. Due to that subjectivity, winning entries will be determined by the judges and all decisions pertaining to the winning entries are final.

There will be two winners per category (theme) and one Best of Competition winner.

Only one prize per entrant will be awarded.

Winning Entries

Winners will be notified after June 1st, 2010 by email.

Digital Show

The winning, runner-up and honourable mention entries will be compiled into a digital slide show. This show will be on display during the Calgary Stampede from July 9th to 18th, 2010 in

the Western Photo Gallery display area of the Western Oasis located in the BMO Centre. Photographers of displayed images will be notified by email prior to Stampede 2010.
