



2016 CALGARY STAMPEDE GRADE 12 ART SCHOLARSHIP INVITATION

On behalf of the Calgary Stampede – Western Showcase Scholarship Committee, we invite students completing their final year of high school in Calgary or Southern Alberta to enter the Calgary Stampede Grade 12 Art Scholarship competition.

Entries for the scholarship will be juried by a panel experienced in the field of art.

All decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final.

Awards: City of Calgary and Southern Alberta (Two prizes awarded in each category)

First Prize \$2000 **Second Prize** \$1,500 **Third Prize** \$1,000

1. The competition is open to all students who are full time residents of Alberta, a Landed Immigrant or Canadian Citizen and are completing their final year of high school in Calgary or Southern Alberta during the 2015/2016 school year. Students who are, or could be repeating their final year of high school are eligible to enter this competition, but may only enter once. Scholarship winners must provide the Scholarship Committee with appropriate documentation by December 2016.
2. The work of art must be entirely the student's **original work (not copied)** and completed independently. Teamwork will not be considered. Only one work per student may be submitted.
3. The work of art must depict themes of western culture, lifestyle, heritage and characters, including but not limited to the following: ranching, landscape, floral, rodeo, agriculture, First Nations and portraits.
4. Any medium (**no photography or digital art**) may be used. All flatwork must be suitably mounted or framed. Three-dimensional work must be suitable for display.
5. Entries must be received between **Saturday, March 5 and Sunday, March 13, 2016. March 13, 2016 as the deadline.** The winning students will be notified by letter.
6. The work of art must be accompanied by a Completed official entry form, which can be obtained from your art teacher. (Art Teachers: one Entry Form is attached. Please photocopy a sufficient supply). Also found on the Calgary Stampede's website.

Deliver the work of art wrapped in paper or boxed with application in an envelope, labeled with your name, taped to the outside to:

7. All winning entrants must display their work of art in the Western Art Show area for the duration of the Calgary Stampede from July 8 to 17, 2016. All other entrants will be displayed depending upon space available. The Scholarship Committee will have the right to exhibit or publish the works of art and the names of the students, in print, voice or visual media. The work of art will be for display only and will not be offered for sale at or through the Calgary Stampede. All art is left at your own risk. The Calgary Stampede is not responsible for loss or damage. Once art is submitted there is no access to the art until Monday, July 18, 2016.
8. **All works of art must be collected by the student or the student designate on Monday, July 18, 2016 between 10 a.m. and noon in Hall D of the BMO Centre. Any work of art that has not been collected on time will be disposed of at the discretion of the committee.**

Criteria for Payment of the Scholarship Award:

By December 2016, scholarship winners must provide the Scholarship Committee with appropriate documentation. (All details will be given to scholarship winners).
